I Need You! To Become **BONE MARROW DONORS**

My name is Kailee Makena Wells. I just turned five years old. When I was a little baby, my Mommy and Daddy, Linda and Owen Wells, came to adopt me in Changsha, Hunan Province of China. Now, I live with my family in the Albuquerque area. Every day since our first day together, my Mommy and Daddy call me their "little angel."

Just after my birthday, I began to have a tummy ache, a cough and a runny nose. It got worse, and I had a fever so high (105.2°), my Mommy and Daddy took me to the Emergency room. My nose started bleeding, and it didn't stop for five long hours. The doctors in Intensive Care said I lost half of the blood in my body, and my bone marrow only had 5% of the required blood cells. My disease is called Very Severe Aplastic Anemia.

Aplastic Anemia is a rare and often fatal disease. It means that my bone marrow is not making any blood cells. Without treatment, I will quite literally run out of blood and die. The best treatment for Aplastic Anemia is AGT Chemotherapy, which I have started. If the Chemo fails, in one to six months, then my only chance is a bone marrow transplant. Since it takes a long time to match bone marrow, my doctors are already trying to locate a match. Asians are more likely to help, although any race may be able to match my bone marrow type.
